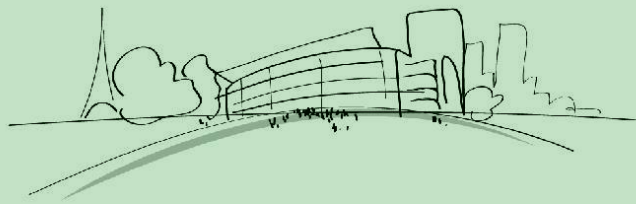

Aim

The Chartered Financial Analyst® (CFA) credential is **the most respected and recognized investment management designation in the world.**

The CFA Programme provides a strong foundation of advanced investment analysis and real-world portfolio management skills. The CFA community is a **global network** of more than 135 000 investment professionals.

Nonetheless, the CFA level I and level II exams are very challenging, with June 2016 candidate success rates of 43% (level I) and 46% (level II).

This CFA Dauphine programme, with its evening and Saturday classroom programme, CFA charterholder instructors, **mock exams** and **individual guidance**, will provide you with the tools and confidence you need to succeed these exams.

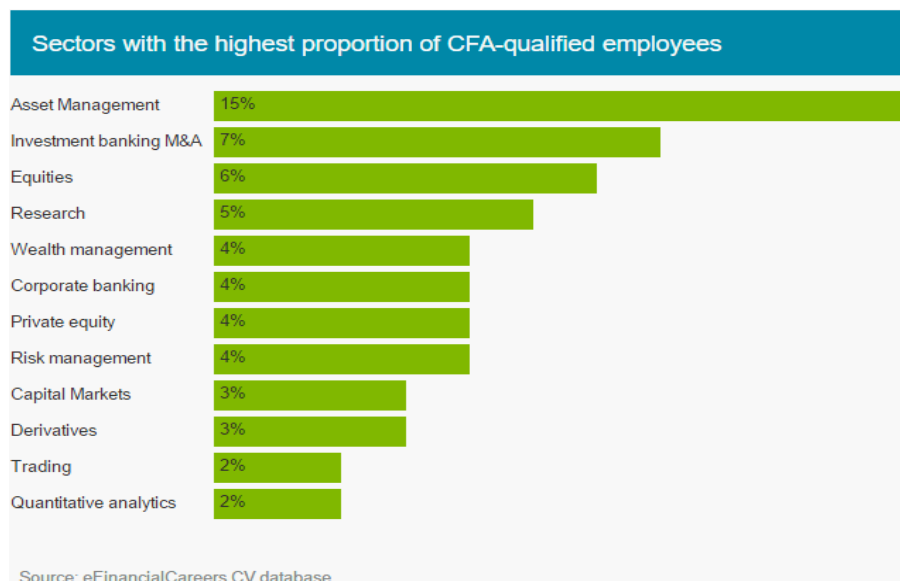

Programme content

The programme consists in evening classes, mock exams and a compulsory internship (for students only).

Evening and Saturday classes

They lay the theoretical bases and delve into the more difficult concepts. These sessions last 3 hours and are held twice a week. They are scheduled either in the evening, or on Saturday morning.

Mock Exams

Students enrolled in the programme will have the opportunity to sit three mock exams (held on Saturdays) before the CFA Level I exam.

Internship (for students only)

A mandatory 6-month internship in a financial institution, giving rise to the preparation of a report, is required. All students enrolled within the Paris-Dauphine in London CFA programme can request a Paris-Dauphine internship agreement.

Individual guidance

Our courses are taught in small groups, to enable each student to benefit from a specific support from our CFA instructors. They remain available to answer our students questions by email and to assess extra tests.

- Graduate or enrolled students in a Master in finance or economics.
- Undergraduate or graduate professionals working in a Finance institution /or within the Finance Function.

Programme fees
